Please can I reminder parents, that children do need to ensure they bring their chromebooks in everyday. They do need to be charged as we have limited capacity to charging in school. Also children do need headphones, as we have various teaching groups within one room.

The Chromebooks are school property and are monitored by school via eSafe monitors user behaviour in the digital environments made available, which is something we purchase through the Local Authority, to ensure our children are safe when online.

Uniform Reminder

Continued practices to keep everyone safe

- Parents will follow the one-way system whilst on site when bringing their child to school. Entering from the top gate and leaving via the bottom gate. Parents to leave children at the top gate in a morning and they can walk down with other children in the year group.
- Parents adhere to the social distance measure in place of 2 metres apart from other family groups.
- Only one adult will bring their child to school.
- Your children will come to school in clean school uniform daily
- Your child will need to bring everyday a packed lunch in a lunch box and a water bottle
- We will not be able to have conversations with parents at the gate, so we ask please that you use Dojo and contact staff.
- If your child develops any symptoms, you will self-isolate the family, you will contact school via 01384 818875 or through dojo to Mrs Holden-Gough
- Parents and children will not congregate at the school gates.
- Parents strictly adhere to the drop off and pick up staggered timings.
- Parents will not be allowed in the school building unless there is an emergency.
