



Code of Conduct whilst on school site during Coronavirus  
lockdown/partial opening provision

- Only 1 parent will drop off and collect their child.
- Parents and children will clearly need to follow the one-way system set out whilst on the school site including school grounds.
- Parents and children must not congregate around the school gates and must ensure, at all times, a 2 metre distance between any other family.
- Children will enter the school through the main top gate and dropped on the car park to the appropriate adult for their group.
- No person will be able to enter the school building with a mask on and will be asked to remove it and throw it in the bin.
- No parent/carer will be allowed into the school building (unless in a medical emergency).
- Parents understand that the school and parents/carers need to undertake as stringent practice as possible to reduce the risks of transmission of the virus (and other illnesses).
- Parents understand that the adults working in the school will try to maintain common sense in terms of social distancing whilst working with the children; however, they are caring for the children and therefore may work closer than 2 metres with them.
- Parents understand that whilst the school will endeavour to regularly clean the areas used and will engage in frequent hand washing, we are unable to guarantee a virus-free school.
- Parents will ensure that their child has high levels of hygiene and cleanliness to reduce risk of transmission.
- Parents will ensure their child has had suntan lotion applied before school as and when required
- Children will wear clean clothes each day (to reduce the risk of transmission).
- Children will not bring any items to the school from home with them except their packed lunch and a coat. (Sunhat when nice weather)
- Children will be encouraged to hold a social distance of 2 metres from any other child or adult within school.

- Children will follow clear social distance rules and if they cannot abide by these, then the children will not be allowed to enter the school building
- Children will follow clear social distance rules and if they cannot abide by these when in school, they will be sent home.
- Parents will not bring any child to the school if they have any symptoms of coronavirus or if anyone in the household has symptoms. In this event, children and the whole household should be isolated for 14 days and school should be informed immediately by message to the mobile phone number - 07572 679423.
- Children with medication for asthma, allergies or other conditions, should ensure that they have the required prescribed medication with them every day in a labelled container. Parents must understand that this medication will come home every day (in case the school has to close without notice). It is parents responsibility to ensure that the medication is in date.
- Parents will inform the member of staff on arrival if they have given their child any medication e.g. Calpol, before coming to school.
- Parents understand that if their child becomes unwell during their time in the school, they will be immediately placed in isolation (in accordance with government guidance) and parents will be contacted and asked to collect them as soon as possible. If parents cannot be reached, the other contacts given will be called. Parents understand that the school staff will not have to prove or justify their decision about a child's illness.
- Parents understand that if their child falls dangerously ill the staff will contact medical services in addition to the parent.
- Parents appreciate that should it become impossible for school to staff the provision due to staff illness or self-isolation, then the childcare will cease with immediate effect and that this may be with very little notice. In this event, school would ensure that parents are directed to alternative provision as agreed with the Local Authority.
