A big thank you for your continued support throughout this Spring term. The children have been amazing in their approaches to all learning that has occurred. I hope you all have a great Easter break and please be safe when going out anywhere during the holiday.

COVID related information and continued practices to keep everyone safe until we break up As the Government release more information around the 'Living with Covid' agenda we wanted to keep you up to date with their advice and guidance.

The key elements are listed below:

- * Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.
- * Adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- * Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days. The date symptoms started will be day zero (if asymptomatic, the date of a positive test will be day zero)

As a school we will continue to keep in place our procedures and protocols. This will include...

- Keeping windows and doors open for ventilation
- Hand sanitiser will be in every classroom and around the school site.
- Anti-bac cleaning materials will be in each classroom.
